Focus:

In recent years there has been an increasing focus on the secure storage and sharing of research data. Institutions and funders have made clear strides toward identifying where and how research data is stored and how access to it is managed.

UWC's Library and eResearch Office will co-host a webinar focussing on the development of Data Management Plans (DMPs). Following a comprehensive template, participants will be introduced to elements that make up a DMP. Participants will also be introduced to online facilities that can assist in the development of DMPs.

Participants will also be introduced to [Kikapu](#), the [UWC Research Data Repository](#). While DMPs attempt to describe the management of research data, the data repository is the actual storage facility where

research data can be securely stored, shared and managed. Participants will be guided to upload research data to [Kikapu](#) and to share it either privately with selected collaborators or publicly with a DOI.
